At the time of writing this article, we have reopened 2 out of 3 of our children's programs: Bible Quest and C Street Kids Children's Church. We are planning to reopen VBS @ MARK Club on November 1st. Bible Quest has averaged over 15 children each week since reopening and we have been so glad to have them back with us again. The challenge of creating a balance between normality and health and safety was daunting. However, we have some amazing volunteers and members of church leadership working with us. Their guidance and suggestions have been a huge aid in getting our programs back on track. Fortunately, our students are used to most of these protocols at school and they have been good sports about it all.

Our first youth group meeting on Wednesday night resumed two weeks ago on September 9th. Since reopening, our highest number in attendance is 17 youth! It's been great to have our youth coming back. I know they are glad to be back with their friends on Wednesday nights again. Right now, they are going through a Bible study provided by our State Convention. This Bible Study was created in lieu of SummerSalt camp and is hosted and written by the SummerSalt staff and SCBC leadership. The youth will resume their Sunday night small groups on November 1st when MARK Club resumes.

It has been a joy and answer to prayers to reopen again. It has been so good to see our children and youth happy to be back at church. Please continue to pray for our ministries as we go forward and our children and youth as they press on with their school year. I am looking forward to introducing our "Concrete and Cranes" VBS curriculum into MARK Club this year. The theme is "building a foundation on Jesus"! What an ideal theme for this year that has been filled with unknowns and uncertainty. We are looking forward to updating you as we begin MARK Club and I know that the children will be excited to share what they have learned this year!

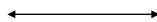

It's easy to tithe and give your offerings online!

Your tithes, offerings, and donations to College Street Baptist can now be made online. Tithing and donating have never been easier. It's quick, easy and secure and you can use debit or credit or check cards, or checking account. Just go to our website at **www.collegestreetbaptist.org** for further information and instructions.

Online giving is not replacing any of the traditional ways we already give, but is an additional option to those who prefer to make their donations by computer, cell phone or other mobile devices. College Street is using a church donation system provided by the Easy Tithe corporation. *EasyTithe* is church specific and is currently used by hundreds of churches across the nation.

You can make a regularly scheduled contribution or you can specify recurring donations. You can specify whether the contribution should go to the general budget or to designated categories. A credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover) or a debit card can be used as well as a regular checking account. The process is secure and confidential and you will have continual access to your giving records.
